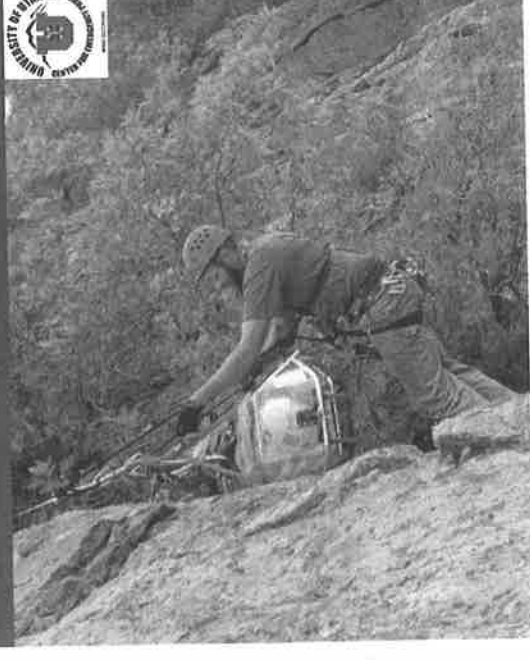

### Steps to obtain your credit:

- Visit: [continue.utah.edu/health\\_education](http://continue.utah.edu/health_education)
- Click on your course and fill out the requested info and payment (You will need your NOLS course number)
- Check if your school will accept the transfer credit (See FAQ's)
- Enjoy your WMI course!
- You will receive a confirmation email from the University of Utah which will also list the semester you are enrolled in and the earliest date you can request your transcript. Transcripts are available after the end of the semester of enrollment.
- To request a transcript, visit <http://registrar.utah.edu/transcripts> or call the Transcript Office at (801)581-8965 to obtain your grade and transcript.

## FAQ:

**Q: Is the credit transferrable to my school?**

A: Most schools will accept credits from the U of U. However, it is up to your institution to decide which and how many credits to accept.

**Q: When can I request a transcript?**

A: The end date of your WMI course determines which semester you are enrolled in. Transcripts are generally available at the end of that semester. (i.e. Fall = mid-December; Spring = mid-May; and Summer = mid-August)

**Q: How do I register for credit?**

A: Go to: [continue.utah.edu/health\\_education](http://continue.utah.edu/health_education), click on your course, and fill out the requested info.

**Q: What type of credit is offered?**

A: Upper division, undergraduate semester credit in Health Promotion
